



### QPP 250: Radical Prostatectomy Pathology Reporting

**Some of my cases should be classified with the “m” suffix. Should I include those cases for this measure? If I add the “m” suffix, does that still count for the pT/pN category?**

As long as these cases were coded as 88309, they should be included in this measure. Adding the “m” suffix does not affect reporting of the pT/pN category; as long as TNM scoring was done, it does not matter what the score was.

**Does QPP 250 include prostate biopsies or only resections?**

QPP 250 includes only prostate resections. However, CAP 38 includes both prostate biopsies **and** resections.
