

House of Delegates Voice of the Membership

Fellow Delegates,

Attached are the results of our annual House of Delegates College Report Card in which you ranked the issues most import to you, and your satisfaction with how well the College is educating you and preparing you to deal with these issues.

This year 190 (61% of delegates) completed this survey, compared to 120 (41% of delegates) completing the survey last year.

The three graphs display the average scoring on a 1-5 scale, 5 being the most import/best educated and prepared and 1 being the least/worst. The graphs compare the 2013 results with those of 2012.

The table shows outlier satisfaction scores which we computed by summing up the averages for the bottom three (1-3) scores. These outliers provide the Board of Governors a different perspective than they might get from eyeballing central tendencies.

We have forwarded this information to the Board of Governors.
