



 CMS contracts with Capitol Bridge, LLC to propose and maintain a system of coding edits to be utilized nationally by all Medicare carriers.

 - NCCI Policy Manual for Medicare Services

NCCI Procedure-to-Procedure Edits

- Released on a quarterly basis
- Oldest edit set in NCCI.
- Code edit pairs and unit of service limitations set by CMS through NCCI
- Example: 88112 (non-gyn Thinprep®) with 88108 (non-gyn Cytospin®)
- CAP is allowed to confidentially review draft edits and provide feedback.
- If published, NCCI PTP edits will appear on CMS website

NCCI Policy Manual For Medicare Services

- Separate process which impacts payment for pathology and laboratory services.
- Written in narrative form, sometimes explaining rationale for edits.
- Chapter 10 is devoted entirely to Pathology & Laboratory Medicine services
- November release anticipated following PFS Final Rule
- CAP review prior to January 1 effective date

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Medically Unlikely Edits

- Originally designed to "limit typographical errors and erroneous claims" (Medically *Unbelievable* Edits)
- Limit units of same service per beneficiary/DoS/MD
- Initiated 1-1-07, released q 2-3 months with 6 weeks for comment
- MAC checks each claim against the MUE on one line* with denial of full claim if MUE exceeded--Instructed to correct "typographical error and resubmit"
- Modifier -59 may allow claims to appear on separate lines and bypass edits*
- CAP is allowed to confidentially review draft edits and provide feedback.
- If published, will appear with NCCI PTP edits on CMS website

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Example Published MUEs for Pathology

CPT Code	Description (abbrev.)	Practitioner MUEs
88108	Cytopathology, concentration technique, smears & interpretation	6
88112	Cytopathology, cellular enhancement technique	6
88331	Frozen Section	11
88332	Frozen Section addl tissue bl.	13
88342	Immhist/cyto, per spec; initial single ab proced	3
88341	Immhist/cyto, per spec; each addl single ab proced	13

- Not all are published.
- Previously adjudicated per line of the claim form (modifiers are on a separate line).
- Now (by CMS Program Integrity) some may be adjudicated by date of service.
 "MUE adjudication indicators—MAI"
